Attention Span in Classes




Attention levels decrease after 10 – 20 minutes, when activity levels are passive



The student feedback...

Staff thoughts



People do not realize how frightened they are. How much lack of confidence exists, how nervous they are and that first introduction to study is an experience which could either make or break them.



Supervision Symposium – The Difficult Conversations

Tips



Be straightforward and honest – don't avoid the issue

Provide a suitable setting – professional but friendly

Change the supervision setting to a neutral environment



Continued

- Communicate honestly with sensitivity
- Don't delay confronting the issue
- Seek the advice of more experienced supervisors
- As long as the underlying attitude is one of respect, honesty and beneficence, most things can be said.



Continued

- Wait until your second thoughts arrive
- Listen carefully, respond minimally, interact.
- Don't delay, talk today.
- Cultural liaison, 3rd party



Continued

- Students expectations re process
- Be specific re expectations

- Get help from external sources if writing problems
- Be upfront that you have to talk about something difficult for you both.



1st year

- Product not knowing what they don't know, different way of learning.
- Students are under lot of pressure with confirmation
- Rules and boundaries, work taken on, expectations



2nd year

- Monitoring role
- When data comes back telling unexpected story
- No of time taken for each task jugling family



3rd year

- Time running out, coherence issues, manage project
- Some students don't want it to end

Some students just want to submit and let the examiners sort it out
